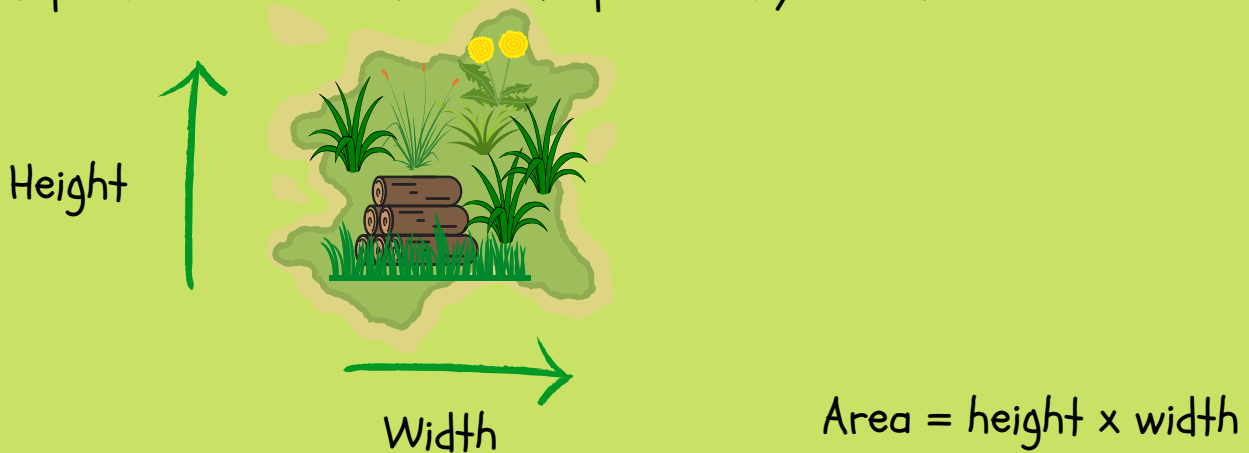


# Wild For Wildlife

Wild' space - anywhere on your school site that is unused and unmanaged (verges, behind buildings, banks etc.) This is where nature can thrive as these areas are quiet, undisturbed and left to grow.

Step One - measure the 'wild' spaces on your site:



Step Two - work out how many metres squared you need to add to make an extra 10% of 'wild' space on your school site:

ie

We have  $30\text{m}^2$  of wild space.

$30\text{m}^2 / 100 = 0.3 \times 10\% = 3\text{m}^2$

Step Three - plan and design your additional space. Below are some ideas:

We made a living wall using tin cans and chicken wire - our school shed is now covered in flowers and bees!
